In 1862, The city of Victoria was incorporated. It is officially named after Oueen Victoria.

Internationally, Victoria is known as the "City of Gardens" and sees billions of blossoms every spring. In 2010, the annual flower count reached a record of 21 billion blooms.

- Victoria's Chinatown is the oldest in Canada, where you can walk down Canada's narrowest street, Fan Tan Alley, measuring 35 inches across.
- Spinnakers is Canada's oldest licensed brewpub, located on the West Shore of Victoria.

- The world's tallest, free-standing totem pole is located in Victoria's Beacon Hill Park.
- There are over 3,500 lights on Victoria's Legislative Building, which turn red and green during Christmas.
